CALL TO ORDER – Mayor Link called the meeting of the Edgewood City Council to order at 6:30 PM in the council chambers of the Edgewood City Building. The following council members were present: Jeff Schreiber, Steve Jaeger, Joe Messmer, Nancy Atkinson, Ray Spears, Dale Henson and Chris Link. Also in attendance were City Attorney Frank Wichmann, City Administrator Doug Beckham and City Clerk Jeanette Kemper.

APPROVAL OF AGENDA

APPROVAL OF MINUTES – May 2, 2011 Meeting Minutes – Mr. Messmer made a motion to adopt the May 2, 2011 meeting minutes as written; second by Mrs. Atkinson. Mr. Spears abstained. Motion passed: 6 ayes – 1 abstention.

REPORT/PRESENTATIONS

Mayor's Report – Mayor Link stated that construction continues on Horsebranch Road with the replacement of the water main and the closure of the e/b 275 ramp is causing traffic backups on Horsebranch and on Dudley. Municipal Government League meeting will be Thursday evening at the Campbell Co Fiscal Court building. Mayor's Group meeting is May 21 at the Ludlow Senior Center at 9 a.m. It's National Public Works Week and Mayor Link thanked the city's public works department for all that they do. Street work is beginning. The city wide and Freedom Park yard sale is Saturday.

Administrator's Report – Mr. Beckham received notice from two ladies who are interested in rezoning property on Roberts Road. It's presently R1C on the south side and R1F on the north side. It will be brought before council in 4 – 6 weeks. There is an email circulating about eliminating the N KY Area Planning Commission and Mr. Beckham recommended that the referendum not be signed.

NEW BUSINESS – Zoning ordinance text amendment request by Ms. Christine Fairfield, to include Child Daycare Centers as a Conditional Use with the PO (Professional Office Building) zone. Ms. Fairfield was not present. Mr. Beckham recommended that it be passed over on the agenda. The location is 970 Dudley Road and Mr. Beckham recommended that it not be approved.

ORDINANCES, MUNICIPAL ORDERS, AND RESOLUTIONS – Municipal Order 2011-06 adding "veterans" to senior center rate sheet. Mr. Wichmann read the municipal order. Mr. Henson made a motion to adopt municipal order 2011-06; second by Mrs. Atkinson. Motion passed: 7 ayes – 0 nays.


ANNOUNCEMENTS

- Mr. Jaeger reminded everyone that tomorrow is Primary Election Day and encourages everyone to get out and vote.


ADJOURNMENT
