












MAYOR'S REPORT BY MAYOR JOHN D. LINK

Now that the colors have gone from the trees and the bushes, reality is setting in that the winter season is soon upon us. With that said, we have a number of activities coming up for you and your family to enjoy. Tree lighting and Chili cook-off; and of course meet Mr. and Mrs. Claus during the holidays. Elaine has all the dates and times in her report, read on!

By now you should have received the Service Line Warranties of America (SLWA) notice in the mail regarding their program to insure your outside water line. Within the next few weeks you will be seeing a program from SLWA to insure your sewer line just like the water line coverage. You have the option to purchase one or both service's or none at all, it's your choice.

In our last newsletter, I advised that we kept the tax rate for the 2011-2012 frozen, as we have done the last three years. I would also like to remind you that, unlike other cities, Edgewood does not have an insurance tax on auto, health or property. If you should find this tax on your policy call your agent and advise that we do not have this tax and adjustments should be made to your policy.

Most, if not all, of the street repairs should be completed this year and those that are not finished will be completed in spring 2012. The sidewalk project on Dixie highway from Dudley to the Crestview Towne Center should be completed by November, weather permitting. This will make it a safer walk to the Crestview Towne Center from our side of the street. We are still planning on resurfacing Horsebranch Road from Thomas More to Orphanage Road this fall now that the water lines have been installed.

I do hope many of your families get together for the Thanksgiving and Christmas Holidays, for it's a great time to meet and see old family and friends. Merry Christmas and Happy New Year to you all.

SNOW EMERGENCY By Stan Goetz, General Services Director

The City of Edgewood has an ordinance that prohibits all motor vehicles from parking on any street in the City during a Snow Emergency. A Snow Emergency may be declared by the Mayor anytime driving conditions are deemed hazardous. It is automatically in effect when there is snow fall of two or more inches. We notify radio and television stations of declared Snow Emergencies, but they do not always broadcast the notice. These notices are not required and you may receive a citation without prior notification. Also, your car may be towed if it creates a hazard on your street. Snow Emergencies are put into effect for your safety as well as the City's. It allows the Public Works Department to plow and salt the thoroughfares without the additional hazards of parked vehicles. If it is snowing, or if snow is predicted, please remove your car(s) from the street.
