REPORT/PRESENTATIONS -

Mayor's Report – The Kenton County Emergency Communications Center is having an open house on Friday, June 28th from Noon until 1:30 p.m. This is the new dispatch center at 1177 Madison Pike in Independence. Please let Jeanette know if you would like to attend. It still looks as though we will join the new dispatch system in August or September of this year. Mayor Link reported on the Northern Kentucky Health Insurance pool; NKADD is having a working session on June 18th and 20th @ 4:00 p.m. in the board room. These working sessions are just an update of the Health Insurance Pool and what can be accomplished; Mayor Link plans to attend the June 20th session.

Administrator's Report – Mayor Link reported on Mr. Beckham's behalf; City Attorney Frank Wichmann is rewriting a couple of the Dudley Hill easements and he will have those ready when Mr. Beckham returns next week. Mayor Link reported that Mr. Beckham is hoping we will go out for bids August 1st.

Mayor Link reported the contractual agreement for this project is well under \$20,000; there are several factors that go into this process however the city will look into it.
