April 16, 2018

CALL TO ORDER – Mayor Link called the meeting of the Edgewood City Council to order at 6:30 PM in the council chambers of the Edgewood City Building. - The White House Event Center will hold an Open House on May 20th from 3–6: pm.


ADJOURNMENT
