

**CITY OF EDGEWOOD
COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES
July 20, 2015
6:30 PM**

CALL TO ORDER – Mayor Link called the meeting of the Edgewood City Council to order at 6:30 PM in the council chambers of the Edgewood City Building. The following council members were present: Nancy Atkinson, Ben Barlage, Dale Henson, Joe Messmer, Rob Thelen and Tony Ward. Also in attendance were City Administrator Brian Dehner, City Clerk Jeanette Kemper and City Attorney Frank Wichmann. Council member Jeff Schreiber was absent.

INVOCATION AND PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

APPROVAL OF AGENDA – Mayor Link added the Family Campout to announcements.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES – June 15, 2015 Council Meeting Minutes – Mrs. Atkinson made a motion to adopt the June 15, 2015 minutes as written; second by Mr. Messmer. **Motion passed: 6 ayes – 0 nays.**

REPORT/PRESENTATIONS – Resident Doug Goessling of 3229 Laurel Oak - Mr. Goessling is concerned about the conditions of Laurel Oak and would like it to be repaved next summer, not the projected 2025 year. Mr. Goessling is also concerned about the blacktop patchwork over the concrete curbs and has requested a resurvey of the Victory Park upgrading.

Mayor's Report – Mayor Link thanked the race sponsors and departments for all the help with the July 4th celebration. Mayor's group meeting was last Saturday. KLC conference starts September 29th in Owensboro if anyone would like to go; this is the start of the legislative kick off for next year. The Lou Noll Symposium is October 17th if anyone would like to attend.

Staff Reports – Council reviewed reports from the following staff members: City Administrator, City Clerk, Fire/EMS, General Services, Police, and Recreation.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS – Dudley Hill Construction – the reflectors and high friction top coat need to be added but this will come later; this project can be removed from the agenda.

Edgewood & Lyndale Road Project – Water lines were hit in the first two days which stopped construction and last Thursday they hit a gas line. Add all the rain on top of these issues and they are already 2-3 weeks behind schedule. Road construction bids could start in April/May of 2016.


ANNOUNCEMENTS
