

**CITY OF EDGEWOOD  
COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES  
March 17, 2014  
6:30 PM**

**CALL TO ORDER** -- Mayor Link called the meeting of the Edgewood City Council to order at 6:30 PM in the council chambers of the Edgewood City Building. The following council members were present: Nancy Atkinson, Ben Barlage, Dale Henson, Joe Messmer, Jeff Schreiber, and Tony Ward. Council member Chris Link was absent. Also in attendance were City Clerk Jeanette Kemper and City Attorney Kim Quinn.

**INVOCATION AND PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE**

**APPROVAL OF AGENDA** – no changes

**APPROVAL OF MINUTES** – March 3, 2014 Council Meeting Minutes – Mrs. Atkinson made a motion to adopt the March 3, 2014 minutes as written; second by Mr. Barlage. **Motion passed: 6 ayes – 0 nays.**

**REPORT/PRESENTATIONS** – **Mayors Report** – **Northern Kentucky Recognition Day** is May 8<sup>th</sup>; retired City Administrator Douglas Beckham will be honored for his recognition as City Administrator of the Year as well as our City Clerk Jeanette Kemper for her recognition as City Clerk of the Year. **CITIZENS DESIRING RECOGNITION ON LEGISLATIVE MATTERS NOT ON THE AGENDA** –

**UNFINISHED BUSINESS** – **Dudley Hill Construction** – Mayor Link is pleased to announce we have all the drawings for the project; we are however about a month behind and plan to start accepting bids in mid-April. KZF projects the majority of the construction will be completed by November 2014 and the bottom should be completed by early spring 2015.

**Edgewood and Lyndale Roads project** – Most of this summer will be taken by the design; the project itself probably won't start until early spring 2015 and continue until 2017.

**NEW BUSINESS** – **Rumpke Snow days** – Mayor Link discussed the trash and recycling pick up issues, the snow caused Rumpke to have many delays in the scheduled pickups. Most residents were picked up a day late. Mr. Henson was concerned about the lack of communication between Rumpke, the city, and the residents; he recommended we post these types of delays on our website and marquee.

Mayor Link thanked all the applicants that applied for the City Administrator position. Brian Dehner was announced as the new City Administrator at the Special Meeting held on March 13, 2014.

**ORDINANCES, MUNICIPAL ORDERS, AND RESOLUTIONS** – **Municipal Order 2014-02** amends Rumpke Municipal Order 2014-01, due to a typographical error. Mr. Henson made a motion to adopt Municipal Order 2014-02; second by Mrs. Atkinson. **Motion passed: 6 ayes – 0 nays.**

Mr. Messmer is concerned about Rumpke violating our contract by picking up trash and recycling before 9:00 a.m. on Dudley Road. This is an ongoing issue; Jeanette has contacted Brett at Rumpke numerous times about this issue. Mr. Henson suggested a letter be sent to Rumpke instead of a phone call.

**Resolution 2014-02 – Approve agreement for Thomas More Parkway traffic signal** – Mrs. Atkinson made a motion to adopt Resolution 2014-02; second by Mr. Messmer. **Motion passed: 6 ayes – 0 nays.**




**ANNOUNCEMENTS**
