

**CITY OF EDGEWOOD  
COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES  
May 4, 2015  
6:30 PM**

**CALL TO ORDER** – Mayor Link called the meeting of the Edgewood City Council to order at 6:30 PM in the council chambers of the Edgewood City Building. The following council members were present: Ben Barlage, Dale Henson, Jeff Schreiber, Rob Thelen and Tony Ward. Also in attendance were City Administrator Brian Dehner, City Clerk Jeanette Kemper and City Attorney Frank Wichmann. Council members Nancy Atkinson and Joe Messmer were absent.

**INVOCATION AND PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE**

**APPROVAL OF AGENDA** – no changes

**APPROVAL OF MINUTES** – April 20, 2015 Council Meeting Minutes – Mr. Barlage made a **motion** to adopt the April 20, 2015 minutes as written; second by Mr. Ward. Mr. Henson abstained. **Motion passed: 4 ayes – 1 abstention.**

**REPORT/PRESENTATIONS** – **Mayor’s Report** – Sanitation District No. 1 would like to receive Resolutions from the cities in regards to the laterals. Absentee ballot registration and voting is May 1 – May 18 at the Covington office. Also, poll workers are needed; please call the city building for contact information.

**Staff Reports** – Council reviewed reports from the following staff members: City Administrator, City Clerk, Fire/EMS, General Services, Police, and Recreation.

**CITIZENS DESIRING RECOGNITION ON LEGISLATIVE MATTERS NOT ON THE AGENDA** – Mr. Harold Trouten of 3087 Winding Trails, resident for 45 years – Mr. Trouten is frustrated with all the door store type ads that get thrown in his driveway; he is hoping the city will help put a stop to these ads. He offered to start a poll on Winding Trails and if residents would like to receive them they can “flag” their mail box and you’ll continue to receive them if you don’t have this “flag” you don’t get one. Mr. Wichmann said there are some ideas out there but no matter how you regulate it, how are you going to enforce it.

**UNFINISHED BUSINESS** – **Dudley Hill Construction** – Sunesis resumed construction on April 20<sup>th</sup>; they will start pouring the aprons tomorrow and the lanes on Wednesday. They are working on getting sod put down for the residents at the top of the hill.

**Edgewood & Lyndale Road Project** – SD1 gave us the go ahead with Dudley Construction, a preconstruction meeting will be scheduled in the next couple of weeks. Dudley Construction will probably start the second week in June. Mr. Schreiber asked about grants, Brian said three Grants were submitted last week, a SNK for construction on Dudley Road from Winding Trails to Thomas More Parkway for fiscal year 2015-2016, another SNK for construction on Dudley Road from Thomas More Parkway to Catherine Drive for fiscal year 2016-2017, and the third is a CMAQ for congestion if this is grant is funded, a possible roundabout will be discussed.

**NEW BUSINESS** – Solid waste bids were opened and proved positive for all but the City of Elsmere. Rumpke offered the lowest bid with a monthly rate of \$17.19, July 1, 2015 – June 30, 2018. – Mr. Henson made a **motion** to accept the Rumpke bid; second by Mr. Barlage. **Motion passed: 5 ayes – 0 nays.**




**ANNOUNCEMENTS**
