

Edge of the Woods Garden Club News

Although Spring has been fickle, it is still time to begin planning for our summer flowers, herbs and vegetables. Before you know it, we will be looking forward to fresh picked vegetables and nothing enhances the flavor of vegetables like fresh herbs! **HERBS** can be started indoors and transferred outside as the soil get warmer - typically Mother's Day. Some herbs can be grown indoors as long as there is ample natural light, as most herbs require at least six hours of sunlight. If planting outdoors, choose a location with full sun and well-drained soil that's not too rich. Herbs don't like 'soggy toes' but require regular rain or watering. If growing in pots, put 1" of gravel in the bottom of the pot for drainage and soil

mix is best with two parts sterile potting soil and one-part perlite.

If you plan to grow a vegetable garden, it's good to know which herbs are "companion plants" for your vegetables.

Here are some companion plant tips:

- Plant Basil with Tomatoes it repels mosquitoes and flies.
- Chives plant with Carrots.
- Dill plant with Cabbages, keep away from Carrots.
- Mint plant near Tomatoes and Cabbages it deters the white cabbage moth.
- Oregano is Companion to all Vegetables.
- Parsley plant near Asparagus, Corn and
- Rosemary plant near Cabbage, Beans, Carrots, & Sage – it deters cabbage moth, bean beetles and
- Thyme plant near cabbage deters cabbage worm, Plant

Tomatoes near Cabbage; plant Radishes near Cucumbers and Spinach to deter cucumber beetles and leaf-miners. Onions repel most pests (yes, even deer!) in March when moving the clocks forward. If not, it isn't too late, so do it now!

I'd like to touch base on "Planning an Escape" from your home in case of a fire:

- MAKE a home escape plan. Draw a map showing the doors/windows and discuss with family members.
- · KNOW at least 2 ways out of every room, if possible. Practice using different ways out.
- HAVE an outside meeting place (tree, light pole, mailbox, neighbors house) a safe distance from the home and preferably in the front yard.
- PRACTICE your home fire drill at night and during the day at least twice a year.
- TEACH children how to escape on their own in case you can't help them.
- CLOSE doors behind you as you leave. This is very important to slow down fire spread.

IF THE ALARM SOUNDS...

 If the smoke alarm sounds, GET OUT AND STAY OUT. Never go back inside for people, pets or

- CALL the 911 (Fire Department) from outside your


