

**CITY OF EDGEWOOD  
COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES  
November 2, 2015  
6:30 PM**

**CALL TO ORDER** – Mayor Link called the meeting of the Edgewood City Council to order at 6:30 PM in the council chambers of the Edgewood City Building. The following council members were present: Nancy Atkinson, Ben Barlage, Dale Henson, Jeff Schreiber, Rob Thelen and Tony Ward. Also in attendance were City Administrator Brian Dehner, City Clerk Jeanette Kemper and City Attorney Frank Wichmann. Council member Joe Messmer was absent.

**INVOCATION AND PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE**

**APPROVAL OF AGENDA** – no changes

**APPROVAL OF MINUTES** – October 19, 2015 Council Meeting Minutes – Mrs. Atkinson made a motion to adopt the October 19, 2015 minutes as written; second by Mr. Thelen. **Motion passed: 6 ayes – 0 nays.**


**ANNOUNCEMENTS**

**ADJOURNMENT**


