

**CITY OF EDGEWOOD
COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES
October 16, 2017
6:30 PM**

CALL TO ORDER – Mayor Link called the meeting of the Edgewood City Council to order at 6:30 PM in the council chambers of the Edgewood City Building. The following council members were present: Nancy Atkinson, Ben Barlage, Dale Henson, Joe Messmer, Jeff Schreiber, Rob Thelen and Tony Ward. Also in attendance were City Administrator Brian Dehner, City Attorney Frank Wichmann, and Senior Deputy Clerk Belinda Nitschke.

INVOCATION AND PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

APPROVAL OF AGENDA – no changes

APPROVAL OF MINUTES – October 2, 2017 Council Meeting Minutes – Mrs. Atkinson made a **motion** to adopt the October 2, 2017 council meeting minutes as written; second by Mr. Ward. **Motion passed: 7 ayes – 0 nays.**

REPORT/PRESENTATIONS - Mayors Report – Mayor Link talked briefly about the upcoming 2018 Legislative Issues. Mayor Link thanked all that attended the KLC Convention; it was a great turn out with the CERS separation being a major topic. Congratulations to Mayor Butch Callery of Villa Hills for receiving the Elected Official of the Year Award.

CITIZENS DESIRING RECOGNITION ON LEGISLATIVE MATTERS NOT ON THE AGENDA – Mike Thelen of 3061 Magnolia presented an Aggressive Traffic Enforcement Study from Fresno California done in 2006; this study was to investigate whether an aggressive traffic violation enforcement program could reduce motor vehicle crashes. After the program was implemented the results showed a significant increase in citations issued and decrease in motor vehicle crashes. Mayor Link thanked Mr. Thelen for the information.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS – Presidents Park White House renovation update – The insulation is in, dry walling will start this week. General Services has been working on the porch, grading the front yard and the accessible ramp. The solar parking lot lights are up. Duke Energy quoted 3K to move the wires and another 7K for the electrician to run the underground conduit and wires.


