

**CITY OF EDGEWOOD
COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES
October 19, 2015
6:30 PM**

CALL TO ORDER – Mayor Link called the meeting of the Edgewood City Council to order at 6:30 PM in the council chambers of the Edgewood City Building. The following council members were present: Nancy Atkinson, Ben Barlage, Dale Henson, Joe Messmer, Jeff Schreiber, Rob Thelen and Tony Ward. Also in attendance were City Administrator Brian Dehner, City Clerk Jeanette Kemper and City Attorney Frank Wichmann.

INVOCATION AND PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

APPROVAL OF AGENDA – Postpone OpenGov presentation until November 2nd due to outdated technology in the council chambers, Brian and Jeanette will work on a solution for the next meeting.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES – October 5, 2015 Council Meeting Minutes – Mrs. Atkinson made a **motion** to adopt the October 5, 2015 minutes as written; second by Mr. Messmer. **Motion passed: 7 ayes – 0 nays.**

REPORT/PRESENTATIONS – **Mayor's Report** – Hinsdale DARE graduation will be November 16th at 7:p.m. and the St. Pius DARE graduation will be held on November 5th at 1:p.m. if anyone would like to attend. Body cameras were discussed for two hours at the Northern Kentucky Student union meeting on October 8th – body camera videos are part of open records therefore it's causing more work for agencies using them, Louisville has hired eight new employees to help with records alone. Mayor Link thanked everyone involved with the Lou Noll Symposium.

CITIZENS DESIRING RECOGNITION ON LEGISLATIVE MATTERS NOT ON THE AGENDA – Mr. Gil Fauber of 560 Garden Way, thanked the council and Mayor for continuing to provide good leadership for the city, he also thanked the first responders and police. Mr. Fauber is concerned about the excessive speeding on Garden Way. Mayor Link suggested we will install more speed limit signs and see if this helps.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS – **Edgewood & Lyndale Road Project** – Brian reported the storm water on Lyndale is complete; they are starting the Edgewood Road section now. We will open Edgewood to Lyndale and Lyndale on through to Turkeyfoot for through traffic, be advised there will be metal grates in the road. The water main work is set to start on December 12th. On a different note, the high friction top coat has been added to Dudley Hill, we should be close to closing out this project.

NEW BUSINESS – none

ORDINANCES, MUNICIPAL ORDERS, AND RESOLUTIONS – Ordinance 2015-08-06 Amending Ordinance 2005-10-12 to include a new section on chickens and fowl – 2nd reading. Mr. Wichmann read the ordinance: **AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF EDGEWOOD, IN KENTON COUNTY, KENTUCKY, AMENDING ORDINANCE 2005-10-12 TO ADD A NEW SECTION PROHIBITING CHICKENS AND OTHER FOWL IN THE CITY AS A NUISANCE, EXCEPT IN CERTAIN CIRCUMSTANCES DESCRIBED THEREIN** – Mr. Schreiber made a **motion** to adopt Ordinance 2015-08-06; second by Mr. Barlage. Mr. Henson voted nay. **Motion passed: 6 ayes – 1 nay.**

Resolution 2015-09 Mayor to sign Dudley project funding agreement – Mr. Messmer made a **motion** to adopt Resolution 2015-09, second by Mr. Henson. **Motion passed: 7 ayes – 0 nays.**


- Tax bills have been mailed; 1st discount (2%) ends November 30th and the base amount is due December 31


ADJOURNMENT
