


# THE CITY OF EDGEWOOD

**Presidential Walkway**



#### ➤ **Adams Shelter**

Holds approximately seventy-five people.

Electrical Outlets, Charcoal Grill, Water Fountain, Lighting  
Sand Volleyball court, tennis courts, and a playground are  
located close to this pavilion.

#### ➤ **Jefferson Shelter**

Holds approximately seventy-five people.

Electrical outlets, Charcoal Grill, Water Fountain, Lighting  
The basketball court is located just in front of this pavilion.

#### ➤ **Madison Shelter**

Holds approximately thirty-five people.

Electrical outlets, Charcoal Grill, Water Fountain, Lighting.  
**Concerts are held at this pavilion each Tuesday  
evening at 7 pm, during the months of June, July  
and August.**

#### ➤ **Washington Pavilion**

Holds approximately fifty people. Time limit – 2 hours.

(This pavilion is open to the public without reservation or  
permit fee. **All are welcome.**)

**Ball fields, restrooms, and the main playground are located  
nearby. (The concession stand is currently closed.)**
