

**CITY OF EDGEWOOD
COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES
March 2, 2015
6:30 PM**

CALL TO ORDER – Mayor Link called the meeting of the Edgewood City Council to order at 6:30 PM in the council chambers of the Edgewood City Building. The following council members were present: Nancy Atkinson, Ben Barlage, Dale Henson, Joe Messmer, Jeff Schreiber, Rob Thelen and Tony Ward. Also in attendance were City Administrator Brian Dehner, City Clerk Jeanette Kemper and City Attorney Frank Wichmann.

INVOCATION AND PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

APPROVAL OF AGENDA – no changes

APPROVAL OF MINUTES – February 2, 2015 Council Meeting Minutes – Mrs. Atkinson made a motion to adopt the February 2, 2015 minutes as written; second by Mr. Henson. **Motion passed: 7 ayes – 0 nays.**

REPORT/PRESENTATIONS – Mayor Link presented a Proclamation to the Turkeyfoot Middle School Cheer Team - the team competed against sixteen other Kentucky schools in the 2014-15 Cheerleading Super Large Division at the KAPOS Middle School State Cheerleading Competition at Eastern Kentucky University finishing first and competing against 28 other schools in the 2014-15 UCA (NHSCC) Cheerleading Junior High Large Division National Competition in Orlando, FL and finishing 3rd in the Nation.

Mayor's Report – KLC City Day/Night – Mayor Link and Brian met with Diane St. Onge; the Mayor also thanked everyone who attended.

Staff Reports – Council reviewed reports from the following staff members: City Administrator, City Clerk, Fire/EMS, General Services – please do not park cars on city streets during snow emergencies, Police, and Recreation.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS – **Dudley Hill Construction** – There was a three to four hour meeting today with Sunesis, the engineers, SD1, NKY Water, the highway department and Frankfort, this was for change orders. Sunesis will start back with construction on April 13th at the bottom of the hill, with concrete. Sunesis would like to close Dudley Road again, Brian and Bob told them they are not in favor of this but would ask council their opinion. Council agreed not to close the road; lane closures are acceptable.

Edgewood & Lyndale Road Project – Brian said we are at a standstill with this right now, SD1 met with CT Consultants to discuss design issues.



Mr. Wichmann read the ordinance: **AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF EDGEWOOD, IN KENTON COUNTY, KENTUCKY, AMENDING THE TEXT OF THE TABLE OF CONTENTS AND SECTIONS 7.0, 8.1, 8.2, 9.19, 9.24, 9.33, 9.34, 17.1, 17.2, 17.3, 18.9 AND OF THE EDGEWOOD ZONING ORDINANCE TO CHANGE VARIOUS TERMS THAT ARE NO LONGER IN USE TO TERMS NOW IN USE; AND TO CLEARLY DEFINE WHO IS THE FLOODPLAIN ADMINISTRATOR.**


ANNOUNCEMENTS
