

**CITY OF EDGEWOOD  
COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES  
March 16, 2015  
6:30 PM**

**CALL TO ORDER** – Mayor Link called the meeting of the Edgewood City Council to order at 6:30 PM in the council chambers of the Edgewood City Building. The following council members were present: Nancy Atkinson, Ben Barlage, Dale Henson, Joe Messmer, Jeff Schreiver, Rob Thelen and Tony Ward. Also in attendance were City Administrator Brian Dehner, City Clerk Jeanette Kemper and City Attorney Frank Wichmann.

**INVOCATION AND PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE**

**APPROVAL OF AGENDA** – Jeff Schreiver asked to add the intersection of Dudley and Turkeyfoot to the agenda.

**APPROVAL OF MINUTES** – March 2, 2015 Council Meeting Minutes – Mr. Henson made a motion to adopt the March 2, 2015 minutes as written; second by Mr. Messmer. **Motion passed: 7 ayes – 0 nays.**

**REPORT/PRESENTATIONS** – Mayor Link presented a Proclamation to the Dixie High School Cheer Team - the team competed against fifteen other Kentucky schools in the 2014-15 Cheerleading Large Varsity Division II at the KHSAA High School State Cheerleading Competition at Eastern Kentucky University finishing fifth in the State and placing first in Region 9. The team then competed against 27 other schools in the 2014-15 UCA (NHSCC) Cheerleading High School Large Varsity Division II National Competition in Orlando, FL and finishing 11<sup>th</sup> in the Nation.

**CT Consultants – Mark and Marty** – A major concern is to alleviate some of the flooding in specific areas. During construction they will restrict traffic to local traffic only. On April 2<sup>nd</sup> they plan to advertise bids, receive the bids on April 16<sup>th</sup> and start construction on May 15<sup>th</sup>, they may push that back until after school lets out for the summer. A public meeting will be held at the Edgewood Senior Center on March 25<sup>th</sup> at 6:30 p.m.

**Mayor's Report – FEMA** approved the grant we applied for on behalf of two residents on Carl Court. Mayor Link thanked Gabe Thelen (Council member Rob Thelen's son) for interviewing the mayor to find out what it's like to run a city. John Stanton with the Kenton County Fiscal Court is looking for college student interns, if you are interested please let us know.

**CITIZENS DESIRING RECOGNITION ON LEGISLATIVE MATTERS NOT ON THE AGENDA** – None

**UNFINISHED BUSINESS** – **Dudley Hill Construction** – April 13<sup>th</sup> is the start date. They will start removing concrete around the Sperti/3L section, as soon as it's dry enough they will start on the sidewalks, that will probably happen around May. They will blacktop last. Tony Ward asked if they could mill the top section transition at Winding Trails. Bob said Sunesis won't do it, but he is going to talk with Brian about doing it ourselves. Brian said they will look into it.

**Edgewood & Lyndale Road Project** – Covered by CT Consultants under Reports/Presentations.

**NEW BUSINESS** – Jeff Schreiver and other residents are concerned about the intersection of Turkeyfoot and Dudley. If you are headed southbound on Turkeyfoot and are in the far left hand turn lane to turn onto Dudley, the northbound traffic is headed straight to you. The lane headed northbound has to veer about four or five feet so they don't hit the southbound traffic sitting in the turning lane. Jeff thinks it's a good idea to put in the traffic cones like they have on Dixie Highway in front of the Crestview Hills Towne Center. Brian will draft a letter to the state regarding this concern.

**ORDINANCES, MUNICIPAL ORDERS, AND RESOLUTIONS** – Ordinance 2015-03-01 – Adopting the 2014 supplement to the code of ordinances –2<sup>nd</sup> reading. Mr. Wichmann read the ordinance: **AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF EDGEWOOD, IN KENTON COUNTY, KENTUCKY, ENACTING AND ADOPTING A SUPPLEMENT TO THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF EDGEWOOD, KENTUCKY.** Mrs.

Atkinson made a motion to adopt Ordinance 2015-03-01; second by Mr. Messmer. **Motion passed: 7 ayes – 0 nays.**


**Ordinance 2015-03-02** – Updating Kenton County Text Amendment terminology – 2<sup>nd</sup> reading. Mr. Wichmann read the ordinance: **AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF EDGEWOOD, IN KENTON COUNTY, KENTUCKY, AMENDING THE TEXT OF THE TABLE OF CONTENTS AND SECTIONS 7.0, 8.1, 8.2, 9.19, 9.24, 9.33, 9.34, 17.1, 17.2, 17.3, 18.9 AND OF THE EDGEWOOD ZONING ORDINANCE TO CHANGE VARIOUS TERMS THAT ARE NO LONGER IN USE TO TERMS NOW IN USE; AND TO CLEARLY DEFINE WHO IS THE FLOODPLAIN ADMINISTRATOR.** Mr. Henson made a motion to adopt Ordinance 2015-03-02; second by Mr. Ward. **Motion passed: 7 ayes – 0 nays.**


**ANNOUNCEMENTS**
