

ADVERTISEMENT TO BID

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that the City of Edgewood, Kentucky hereinafter referred to as the Owner, will receive sealed bids for the **BEECH DRIVE CUL-DE-SAC IMPROVEMENT PROJECT**.

The project consists of the construction of 112 FEET OF 24 FEET WIDE CONCRETE STREET AND UTILITIES. Bids shall be by UNIT COST for this project. Units and scope of work shall include but not limited to clearing, earthwork, sanitary sewer improvements, storm sewer improvements, underground electric conduits, concrete paving, water main improvements, and erosion control.

Sealed Bids are invited and may be forwarded by registered mail, addressed to the City of Edgewood, 385 Dudley Road, Edgewood, KY 41017 or delivered in person, not later than **2:00 PM EDT (Local Time) on Friday, July 1, 2016** at which time the bids will be read aloud. Bids received after said hour shall be returned unopened.

Contractors and subcontractors are not required to pay the Prevailing Construction Wage Rates established by the Kentucky Department of Labor

All materials furnished and labor performed incidental to and required for the proper and satisfactory execution of the contract shall be furnished and performed in accordance with the requirements of the drawings and specifications, and any addenda thereto, prepared by Land Consultants, 314 Front Street, Lawrenceburg, Indiana, 47025. Said drawings and specifications are included in the construction documents and are on file for public inspection at: the City Building, 385 Dudley Road, Edgewood, KY. Copies of these documents may be obtained from the office of City of Edgewood, KY upon payment of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) per set. Checks shall be made payable to City of Edgewood. This payment is non-refundable. Partial sets of Drawings and Specifications are not available.

The work to be performed and the bid to be submitted, including any and all separate and combination bids, shall include sufficient and proper sums for all general construction, mechanical installation, electrical installation, labor, materials, tools, equipment, taxes, (both federal and state) if applicable, permits, licenses, service costs, and so forth incident to and required for the construction of the above listed project.

Each bid must be enclosed in a sealed envelope bearing the title of the project, "**BEECH DRIVE CUL-DE-SAC IMPROVEMENT PROJECT**", and the name and address of the Bidder.

Bids shall be properly and completely executed on bid forms included in the Specifications. Each bid shall be accompanied by a certified check or acceptable bidder's bond made payable to the Owner, in a sum of not less than five percent (5%) of the total amount of the highest aggregate bid, which check or bond will be held by the Owner as evidence that the bidder will, if awarded a contract or contracts, enter into the same with the Owner upon notification from him to do so within ten (10) days of said notification.

Approved Performance and Payment Bonds guaranteeing faithful and proper performance of the work and materials, to be executed by an acceptable Surety Company, will be required of Contractor at the time he executes his contract. The Bond will be the amount of 100% of the Contract Price and must be in full force and effect for a period of 12 months from the date of acceptance of and final payment for the work.

Failure to execute a contract and to furnish a Performance and Payment Bond as hereinafter set out will be cause for forfeiture to the Owner of the amount of money represented by the certified check or Bidder's Bond, as and for liquidated damages.

No bids shall be withdrawn after the opening of the bids without the consent of the Owner for a period of sixty (60) days after bid opening.

The Owner reserves the right to reject any bid, or all bids, or to accept any bid or bids, or to make such combination of bids as may seem desirable, and to waive any and all informalities in the bidding.
