OCTOBER

October 7, 2024 is the deadline to register to vote so you can vote in the General Election.

Have You Checked Your Registration?

To confirm you are registered and verify your address visit **www.GoVote.KY.gov** and click on *"Review Your Registration."*

Did You Move WITHIN Kenton County?

When and where you reside affects what precinct specific ballot you receive. If you move anywhere or anytime within Kenton County, you will always be able to vote but you will need to update your address.

Did You Move TO Kenton County?

When and where you reside affects if you can vote and what ballot you receive.

October 7, 2024, is the deadline to register to vote so you can vote in the General Election.

When Can You Vote?

Sat, Sept 21 - Tues, Oct 22, 2024 Wed, Oct 23 - Wed, Oct 30, 2024 Thurs, Oct 31 - Sat Nov 2, 2024 Monday, November 4, 2024 Tuesday, November 5, 2024

Did You Review Your Ballot?

In a General Election you can vote for any candidate of your choosing. Please review your precinct-specific ballot before voting. To find sample ballots go to **kentoncountykyclerk.com**. Sample ballots will not be available until September 16, 2024.

How Do We Vote In Kenton County?

Early voting uses voting centers. You can go to any available locations to vote and receive your precinct specific ballot.

On Election Day, you can go to any of the available locations if you are willing to use the Express Vote ballot marker.

If you require a pre-printed ballot you must go to the location assigned to your precinct.

Where Can You Vote?

During Early Voting you can go to any of the available voting centers to receive your precinct specific ballot.

Portal is open for mail-in absentee requests
Excuse Voting (6-day) - 7:30 am to 4 pm
Early Voting - 7:30 am to 4 pm
No voting
ELECTION DAY - 6 am to 6 pm
