

**CITY OF EDGEWOOD
COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES**

June 18, 2018

6:30 PM

CALL TO ORDER – Mayor Link called the meeting of the Edgewood City Council to order at 6:30 PM in the council chambers of the Edgewood City Building. The following council members were present: Ben Barlage, Joe Messmer, Jeff Schreiber, Rob Thelen and Tony Ward. Also, in attendance were City Administrator Brian Dehner, Senior Deputy Clerk Belinda Nitschke and City Attorney Frank Wichmann. Council members Nancy Atkinson and Dale Henson were absent.

APPROVAL OF AGENDA – no changes

APPROVAL OF MINUTES – June 4, 2018 MRAF Public Hearing Minutes – Mr. Messmer made a **motion** to adopt the June 4, 2018 MRAF Public Hearing minutes as written; second by Mr. Schreiber. **Motion passed: 5 ayes – 0 nays.**

Municipal Order 2018-03 adopting updated job descriptions – Mr. Ward made a **motion** to adopt Municipal Order 2018-03, second Mr. Messmer. **Motion passed: 5 ayes – 0 nays.**


