COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES  
April 15, 2019  
6:30 PM**

**CALL TO ORDER** – Mayor Link called the meeting of the Edgewood City Council to order at 6:30 PM in the council chambers of the Edgewood City Building. The following council members were present: Ben Barlage, Dale Henson, Joe Messmer, Jeff Schreiber, Rob Thelen, Tony Ward and Kim Wolking. Also, in attendance were City Administrator Brian Dehner, City Clerk Belinda Nitschke and City Attorney Frank Wichmann.

**INVOCATION AND PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE**

**APPROVAL OF AGENDA** – Mr. Messmer added Rental Properties as item #20.

**APPROVAL OF MINUTES** – April 1, 2019 Council Meeting Minutes – Mr. Messmer made a **motion** to adopt the April 1, 2019 minutes as written; second by Mrs. Wolking. Mr. Henson and Mr. Thelen abstained. **Motion passed: 5 ayes – 2 abstentions.**


**ADJOURNMENT**
