

**CITY OF EDGEWOOD  
COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES  
September 16, 2019  
6:30 PM**

**CALL TO ORDER** – Mayor Link called the meeting of the Edgewood City Council to order at 6:30 PM in the council chambers of the Edgewood City Building. The following council members were present: Ben Barlage, Dale Henson, Joe Messmer, Jeff Schreiber, Rob Thelen and Kim Wolking. Also, in attendance were City Administrator Brian Dehner, City Clerk Belinda Nitschke and City Attorney Frank Wichmann. Council member Tony Ward was absent.

**INVOCATION AND PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE**

**APPROVAL OF AGENDA** – no changes

**APPROVAL OF MINUTES** – August 19, 2019 Council Meeting Minutes – Mr. Thelen made a motion to adopt the August 19, 2019 minutes as written; second by Mrs. Wolking. **Motion passed: 6 ayes – 0 nays.**

**REPORT/PRESENTATIONS** – Mayor's Report – KLC conference will be held on September 24<sup>th</sup> – 27<sup>th</sup> in Covington, KY. On September 26<sup>th</sup> at the KLC conference they will host the gubernatorial candidates. September 21<sup>st</sup> the Mayor's meeting will be hosted by Taylor Mill at Pride Parkway. The City of Edgewood is ranked 40<sup>th</sup> out of 50 cities of the best cities to live in the US according to USA Today.

Staff Reports – Mr. Messmer asked if our engineer could look at the light at KY 17 and Dudley. Mr. Dehner stated that it was a State controlled light and we have repeatedly have asked for changes from the state for the light. Mayor Link stated the State has stated that they do not have the funds to make changes to the median and the I-275 entrance. City Administrator, City Clerk, Fire, General Services, Police and Recreation reports were reviewed.

Mr. O'Connor asked if council has ever heard of Collins and Company and if they have any association with the city. Mr. Wichmann and Mr. Dehner stated no they did not have any association. Mr. O'Connor submitted an incident report to SD1. Mr. Dehner stated that he has asked for documentation and information from Mr. O'Connor and he has not submitted it to the city yet. Mr. Schreiber stated that he had a similar situation and his claim was denied but he went to his insurance company and they covered his claim. Mr. Schreiber asked if Mr. O'Connor's insurance is covering his damage. Mr. Schreiber asked that the city approve the resolution now to address the issue.
