Mayor's Report – Mayor's Group is supporting the free CERS bill. The Police Chief's Association is supporting the creation of a Police Academy in Northern Kentucky. PDS Management Board is made up of Kenton County, Independence, Covington and Erlanger and three at large representatives for the smaller cities and meet twelve times a year.
