<u>REPORT/PRESENTATIONS</u> – Senator Chris McDaniel – Legislative Update – The Legislature now allows the shipping of alcohol to residences in Kentucky. The legislature has passed a one-year budget. Voter Identification law was passed. 113 million road funds were acquired for the area with 7 million for Turkeyfoot Road to help with traffic congestion. CERS contribution rate was stabilized and created a budget savings. Vaping items are now subject to tax. The budget will need to be revised in the next session in January.

Mayor's Report – City Attorney Frank Wichmann was featured in Kentucky City Magazine. Dennis Gordon has retired from PDS. On August 6th there will be a public hearing on the comprehensive plan meeting. Officer Gary Linn has retired from the city as the SRO for Dixie Heights High School. Officer John Mairose will take his place as SRO. Officer Tyler Creech was diagnosed with a brain tumor and will be having surgery soon. We wish him well and he is in the city's thoughts and prayers. Mr. Dehner thanked the Department heads for all of their hard work and dedication during this pandemic.
