Postage is pre-paid on return envelope. **Don't forget to sign BOTH envelopes. Must be postmarked by Election Day, November 3, 2020.** Or put in drop off box at 1840 Simon Kenton Way, Cov. or Independence Courthouse at 5272 Madison Pike, Ind.
