May 17, 2021**


**CALL TO ORDER** – Mayor Link opened the Municipal Road Aid Fund public hearing at 6:30 P.M. in the council chambers of the Edgewood City Building.

**ROLL CALL** - The roll was called to determine a quorum. The following council members were present: Bene Barlage, Dale Henson, Darla Kettenacker, Joe Messmer, Jeff Schreiber, Rob Thelen and Kim Wolking. Also, in attendance were City Administrator Brian Dehner, City Clerk Belinda Nitschke and City Attorney Frank Wichmann.

**PUBLIC HEARING** – Mayor Link addressed the audience and council for any questions or discussions in regard to the Municipal Road Aid Fund. He announced that the City expects to receive approximately \$175,000 for fiscal year 2021-2022; it will be used in the general fund for road repairs.


