HIRING NOTICE

PART-TIME FIREFIGHTER/EMT or PART-TIME FIREFIGHTER/MEDIC

The City of Edgewood is currently accepting applications and resumes for the positions of a part-time Firefighter/EMT or Firefighter/Medic. The primary responsibilities of this position will include, but not limited to providing BLS or ALS care and firefighter suppression skills to the communities we serve. Other duties and responsibilities are listed in the job description on file.

To be eligible for hire, candidates must be at least 21 years of age, be able to speak, read, and write the English language, pass background checks, pre-employment physical, and drug screening. Candidates must also pass a department issued physical agility test or hold a current CPAT card not more than 12 months old. Notification of testing will be set after applications have been received.

SALARY/BENEFITS:

- Hourly rate of \$16.50 FF/EMT
- Hourly rate of \$18.15 FF/Medic
- Kentucky CERS Hazardous Duty Retirement (if eligible)

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

- Must obtain Kentucky 150-hour certification within one (1) year from appointment.
- Must be a Kentucky certified Emergency Medical Technician or Paramedic and maintain.
- Must have a valid driver's license and clean driving record.

RESPONSIBILITIES INCLUDE A MINIMUM OF THE FOLLOWING:

- Respond to Fire and EMS emergencies.
- Perform vehicle preventive maintenance inspections and upkeep.
- Assist in fire hydrant testing and maintenance duties.
- Perform general building maintenance and housekeeping duties.
- Other duties included in City of Edgewood position description.

TO APPLY:

Candidates **MUST** submit a copy of your driver's license, Social Security card, high school diploma (or equivalent), Kentucky Fire Commission Training summary report (or equivalent) if applicable, all pertinent Emergency Medical certifications and/or all pertinent firefighter certifications with the application. Applications are available at the Edgewood Municipal Building located at 385 Dudley Road between 8:00 am – 6:00 pm, Monday thru Friday or can be found at **www.edgewoodky.gov**.

Applications and required documents will be received at the city building until June 8, 2022. Applicants must provide a valid email address with their application as all notifications and communication will be made via email. Candidates who meet these requirements will be notified via email of the scheduled physical agility assessment if the candidate does not possess a current CPAT card.
