CITY OF EDGEWOOD COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES October 3, 2022 6:30 PM

<u>CALL TO ORDER</u> – Mayor Link called the meeting of the Edgewood City Council to order at 6:30 pm. The following council members were present: Ben Barlage, Dale Henson, Darla Kettenacker, Joe Messmer, Jeff Schreiver and Rob Thelen. Also, in attendance were City Administrator Brian Dehner, Senior Deputy Clerk Michelle Frisch and City Attorney Frank Wichmann, Council Member Kim Wolking was absent.

INVOCATION AND PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

<u>CITIZENS DESIRING RECOGNITION ON LEGISLATIVE MATTERS NOT ON THE AGENDA</u> – Mr. Scott Spille, 3019 Winterbourne – asked the city to advertise that October 29, 2022 is DEA Drug Take Back Day on our website and via Reach Alert.

Kurt Hanscom, 232 North Colony – Mr. Hanscom would like to see a project list in the newsletters. Mr. Hanscom asked why the city does not charge a fee to use a credit card. Mr. Dehner explained that the credit card fees are built into the budget.

REPORT/PRESENTATIONS – Mayor's Report – Magnolia Court is now finished. Ortho Cincy on Dixie Highway will have its grand opening on October 20th at 5:30pm. Taco Bell is in the process of building on Dixie Highway. 2023 Kentucky Legislative preview process is starting. Mayor Link spoke with Representative Moser about those topics. KLC is very instrumental in this process and are lobbyists for the cities. Mayor Link and council expressed their deepest sympathies to Jack Kleier on the passing of his wife.

The new location would be in place of the swing's location at the back playground location. The location is 30' x 40' and the swing set is not in compliance. Council discussed the location and whether to go forward with design of the project. Mr. Thelen made a **motion** to go forward with the design of the Learning Garden; second by Mr. Messmer. **Motion passed:** 6 ayes – 0 nays.

Mayor Link displayed our new banners for the light poles and that this upcoming year will be the city's 75th anniversary.
