

**CITY OF EDGEWOOD
COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES
November 7, 2022
6:30 PM**

CALL TO ORDER – Mayor Link called the meeting of the Edgewood City Council to order at 6:30 pm. The following council members were present: Ben Barlage, Dale Henson, Darla Kettenacker, Joe Messmer, Jeff Schreiber, Rob Thelen and Kim Wolking. Also, in attendance were City Administrator Brian Dehner, City Clerk Belinda Nitschke and City Attorney Frank Wichmann.

INVOCATION AND PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

CITIZENS DESIRING RECOGNITION ON LEGISLATIVE MATTERS NOT ON THE AGENDA – None

APPROVAL OF AGENDA – Mr. Schreiber asked for an update on the NKY Water District project on Dudley Road. Mr. Dehner has been in contact with the NKY Water District, he stated they would be repairing the road prior to the snow season. Mr. Henson asked for an update on the SafeHaven Baby Box project. Mr. Dehner stated that the contract has been signed and payment has been sent. SafeHaven would not start until they received payment.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES – October 17, 2022 Council Meeting Minutes – Mrs. Kettenacker made a **motion** to adopt the October 17, 2022 minutes as written; second by Mr. Messmer. **Motion passed: 7 ayes – 0 nays.**

REPORT/PRESENTATIONS – Police Department Accreditation Re-certification – Chief Zurborg and Sergeant Mike Winkler explained to council the re-certification process and requirements. Chief Zurborg stated that it was an extensive process and Sergeant Winkler spent at least 6 months working on this accreditation.

Mayor’s Report – A new representative will be needed for TBNK in January to replace Dale Henson. Mayor Link thanked Dale Henson for his service on the TBNK Board. The Legislative Sessions Preview Conference will begin on November 14th. Breeze Airways will be flying out of CVG starting February 2023. PDS will be starting a monthly newsletter. KLC City official’s Orientation/Academy will be held in December and January. KLC City Day/Night will be held on February 22nd. KLC presented Representative Kim Moser with a “Friend of Kentucky Cities” award.


- City Administration Offices will be closed – Friday, November 11th for Veteran’s Day
