Military Banner Program Information

The City of Edgewood Military Banner Program was established in 2021 to honor and recognize hometown active-duty and veterans of the United States Armed Forces.

Banners will display the official military photo of the service person, as well as their name, rank and branch of service. The cost of each banner is \$150, which includes a 30' x 80' double sided, vinyl banner and installation for the seasons.

Criteria

To qualify for the Military Banner Program, the following criteria must be met:

- The Honoree is currently serving as an active duty member of the United States Armed Forces, is a Retired Veteran, or deceased service personnel.
- Currently residing or former resident of Edgewood or have an immediate family member residing in Edgewood (parent, spouse, sibling, son, daughter, aunt, uncle, grandparent).

Process

Applications are accepted starting on the first work day of January with a limit of 20 banners. Military Banners are installed along Dudley Road (between Presidents Park and Freedom Park) beginning the week before Memorial Day through Veteran's Day for two seasons. Once these two seasons have passed the banner will be returned to the applicant.

Applications must include the following:

- A minimum 5x7 photo (color or black/white) of the service person in his/her uniform (but not necessary) with a resolution of 300 dpi or higher.
- Verification of military status (DD-214, Military ID, or other paperwork)
- Applicant Proof of residency (driver's license or equivalent)

YOU MUST COME TO THE CITY BUILDING TO COMPLETE APPLICATION WITH ALL REQUIRED PAPERWORK. Once the application is submitted, banners will be processed as a group. All applications must be submitted with payment, photo and verification by the end of the day on **the first work day of March.**

DISCLAIMER: Quantity is limited to one (1) banner per service person. *The spelling of the name will be taken directly from the application.* Installation location and removal of banners are at the City's discretion. The city is not responsible for lost/stolen banners, or repairs to the banners should they be damaged from weather or normal warranty work.
