ORDINANCE NO. 2023-05-04

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF EDGEWOOD IN KENTON COUNTY, KENTUCKY, ESTABLISHING THE ANNUAL RESIDENTIAL GARBAGE COLLECTION ASSESSMENT AND FEES FOR TWICE A WEEK COLLECTION RESIDENTIAL GARBAGE AND ONCE PER WEEK RESIDENTIAL RECYCLING COLLECTION.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF EDGEWOOD, IN KENTON COUNTY, KENTUCKY, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1.0 - Amendment:

Section II of Edgewood Ordinance 1986-5 as previously amended from time to time, is hereby again amended as follows, with the text being added indicated by a single line drawn underneath it, and the text intended to be removed marked at the beginning with an opening bracket and at the end with a closing bracket with the text in between the brackets stricken through with a single line, as required by KRS 83A.060(3):

SECTION II

In order to provide the funds necessary for the payment of the costs and expenses incurred by the City of Edgewood in providing for the aforedescribed residential garbage collection system; and in order to equitably distribute the cost thereof, there is hereby established, assessed, levied and imposed upon each lot or parcel of real estate in the City of Edgewood upon which there is constructed a residential structure, and upon the owners thereof, jointly and severally, an annual residential garbage collection fee for the following fiscal years for each residential unit:

Fiscal Year(s)	Unit of Measure	Unit Cost
July 1, 2023 to June 30, 2025	Per Year	\$342.00
July 1, 2025 to June 20, 2027	Per Year	\$377.00
Extension July 2027 - June 30, 2029	Per Year	\$415.00

Section 2.0 - Provisions Severable

The provisions of this ordinance are severable; and the invalidity of any provision of this ordinance shall not affect the validity of any other provision thereof; and such other provisions shall remain in full force and effect as long as they remain valid in the absence of those provisions determined to be invalid.

Section 3.0 - Conflicting Ordinances Repealed

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 4.0 - Effective Date

This ordinance shall be effective as soon as possible according to law.

Section 5.0 - Publication

This ordinance shall be published in summary pursuant to KRS 83A.060(9)
