**A MUNICIPAL ORDER OF THE CITY OF EDGEWOOD, IN
KENTON COUNTY, KENTUCKY, DECLARING LISTED
PROPERTY OWNED BY THE CITY TO BE SURPLUS.**

SECTION I

A 2006 F450 Crew Cab Tool Truck, 1998 GMS 8500 Dump Truck, Flashing School Zone Signs (4), 4'x10' Single Axle Trailer, 16' Smith Trailer, Mill 250 Milleromatic Welder, U-Channel Sign Posts, McMillen Extreme Duty Skid Steer Auger, Above Ground 1K Gallon Unleaded Fuel Tank.

The findings required by KRS 82.083 are attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

SECTION II



Sale or Other Disposition of City Property
As per KRS 82.083 Definition; sale or other disposition of property

The Method of disposition to be used:

- Transferred, with or without compensation to another agency;
- Transferred with or without compensation, for economic development purposes, which shall include but not be limited to real property transfers for the elimination of blight;
- Sold at public auction following publication of the auction in accordance with KRS 424.130(1)(b);
- Sold by electronic auction following publication of the auction, including the uniform resource link (URL) for the site of the electronic auction, in accordance with KRS 424.130(1)(b);
- Sold by sealed bids in accordance with the procedure for sealed bids under KRS 45A.365(3) and (4);
- Traded towards the purchase of the same or similar type of property, if the trade-in value received equals or exceeds the actual fair market value of the property as determined using an independent appraisal;
- Sold for its appraised fair market value or a greater amount if the property is valued at five thousand dollars (\$5,000) or less in an independent appraisal. Property sold under this paragraph may not be sold to a city officer or employee or family member of a city officer or employee as defined in the city's ethics ordinance adopted under KRS 65.003;
- Sold for scrap or disposed of as garbage in a manner consistent with the public interest if the property has no value or is of nominal value as determined by an independent appraisal; or (**due to accident, insurance company deemed vehicle total loss and title will be transferred to insurance company**);
- Sold by the Finance and Administration Cabinet under an agreement with the city.
- Sold to employee pursuant to KRS 65.041.

NOTE:

If the city receives no bids for the real or personal property, either at public or electronic auction or by sealed bid, the property may be disposed of consistent with the public interest, in a manner deemed appropriate by the City. In those instances, a written description of the property, the method of disposal, and the amount of compensation, if any, shall be made.

Any compensation resulting from the disposal of this real or personal property shall be transferred to the general fund of the city.

2006 F450 Crew Cab Tool Truck: Vin #1FDXW47P06ED06596, with 82,000 miles. The intended use of the vehicle at the time of purchase was for general maintenance purposes by the department. It is in the public interest to dispose of the vehicle because it is beyond its' useful service life for the department and has been replaced with a new vehicle.

1998 GMS 8500 2.5 Dump Truck (unit # 2201: VIN 1GDP7H1C1WJ51332, with 52,000 miles. The intended use of the vehicle at the time of purchase was for general maintenance purposes by the department. It is in the public interest to dispose of the vehicles because it is beyond its' useful service life for the department and has been replaced with a new vehicle.

Four (4) electric powered flashing School Zone signs. No make or model information is available. The intended use of the school zone signs at the time of purchase was to alert the traveling public when they were entering a school zone within the city limits. It is in the public interest to dispose of the school zone signs because they are beyond their useful service life and have been replaced with solar school zone signs.

4' x 10' Single axle trailer. No information available regarding make, model or age. The intended use of the trailer at the time of purchase was for general maintenance purposes by the department. It is in the public interest to dispose of the trailer because it is beyond its' useful service life for use by the department.

16' Smith trailer (Unit # 2211) GVWR 10,400 lbs. No information available regarding model number or age. The intended use of the trailer at the time of purchase was for general maintenance purposes by the department. It is in the public interest to dispose of the trailer because it is beyond its' useful service life and has been replaced with a new trailer.

Miller 250 Millermatic Welder (Unit # 2216). The intended use of the Miller 250 Millermatic welder at the time of purchase was for general maintenance purposes by the department. It is in the public interest to dispose of the welder because it is beyond its' useful service life for use by the department has been replaced with a new mig welder.

Pallet of assorted length U-channel sign posts. The intended use of the u-channel sign posts at the time of purchase was for the City's street sign program. It is in the public interest to dispose of the u-channel sign post because the department eliminated the use of u-channel sign posts.

McMillen Extreme Duty Skid Steer Auger (Unit # 2207). The intended use of the McMillen Extreme Duty Skid Steer Auger at the time of purchase was for general maintenance purposes by the department. It is in the public interest to dispose of the auger because it is beyond its' useful service life for use by the department.

Above Ground 1,000 Gallon Unleaded Fuel Tank with Containment Wall. The intended use of the 1,000 gallon above ground unleaded fuel tank with containment wall at the time of purchase was for the storage of unleaded fuel for use of in City vehicles. It is in the public interest to dispose of the above ground fuel tank with containment wall because the containment wall has deteriorated and is beyond its' useful service life and the unleaded fuel tank has been replaced with a new fuel tank/containment wall.
