COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES
April 1, 2024
6:30 PM**

CALL TO ORDER –Mayor Link called the meeting of the Edgewood City Council to order at 6:30pm. The following council members were present: Darla Kettenacker, Joe Messmer, Jeff Schreiber, Rob Thelen and Kim Wolking. Also, in attendance were City Administrator Brian Dehner, City Clerk Belinda Nitschke, and City Attorney Frank Wichmann. Council members Ben Barlage and Scott Spille were absent.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES – March 18, 2024 Council Meeting Minutes – Mrs. Wolking made a **motion** to adopt the March 18, 2024 minutes as written; second by Mr. Thelen. **Motion passed: 5 ayes – 0 nays.**

REPORT/PRESENTATIONS – Mayors Report – Mayor Link announced Kenton County Clerk, Gabrielle Summe provided information on the upcoming primary election. There is information on their website at: www.kentonky.clerk.com. The veto session runs from March 29th – April 9th to the Governor’s office. April 12th – April 15th is the veto override session. Mayor Link introduced the interim police chief, Jimmy Kreinest. Chief Kreinest has been with the department since June 2011, moved to investigative work in 2017 and promoted to a sergeant in 2020. Chief Kreinest thanked the mayor and council for the opportunity to serve as interim chief.

Mrs. Wolking asked for an update on Dudley Road and Ky 17 alignment. Mr. Dehner stated that the project did make the state budget. Mr. Dehner does not know when the project will start or if they have been in contact with any property owners. Mr. Dehner stated that once the budget is approved the city will contact KY District 6 regarding the project.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS – Golf Cart Ordinance – Council discussed the draft golf cart ordinance with the changes that council asked for. Mrs. Kettenacker made a **motion** to table the Golf Cart Ordinance indefinitely; second by Mr. Messmer. **Motion passed: 5 ayes – 0 nays.**


ANNOUNCEMENTS
